Vision Technologies Awarded Passive Optical Network Installation

Vision is also providing the network management software application and training for the CBHA staff. The system design will enable future growth and flexibility for any Ethernet application.

CBHA's Doug Thompson explained, "We were seeking a partnering relationship with a company capable of designing and implementing a high-speed, highly reliable GPON network in our newest clinic, currently under construction. Preference was given to companies that can also train CBHA's technical staff on system operation and provide upper tier support on an ongoing basis. We are very pleased to be working with Vision Technologies on this project."
